# Government of Telangana:

**Empowering Start-Ups and Incubators Since its Formation**

## Context

- Since its formation, the Government of Telangana(GoTS) has taken a keen interest in the encouraging a culture of innovation within the state and has been working relentlessly to develop a holistic Start-up ecosystem to aid the same.
- GoTS continues to augment both the physical infrastructure required as well as policy support measures needed to support this ecosystem.
- The purpose of this presentation is to empower Start-ups and Incubators in Telangana with information about:
  - The various support measures and benefits the government has to offer.
  - The procedures one needs to follow to to avail the same.

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# Telangana is one of the first states to launch a Start-up policy and create a supportive ecosystem around it.

Within two years of formation of Telangana, IT Minister had launched "<u>The</u> <u>Innovation Policy</u>" of state which defines a holistic approach to bridge the gaps between Start-ups and government and to build the Start-up ecosystem.

# The GoTS Innovation Policy focuses on developing Incubators as a key catalyst for Entrepreneurship Ecosystem and has numerous provisions to aid them.

Financial Assistance	<ul> <li>Incubator development fund for any PPP model.         <ul> <li>Prerequisites: Must be recognized by NSTEDB, DST, Government of India (GoI) and must adhere to operational guidelines (scale, sector)</li> </ul> </li> <li>Financial Assistance as Matching Grants are available.         <ul> <li>Prerequisites: Must have already received funding from GoI.</li> </ul> </li> <li>A performance-linked assistance model is currently in the works.</li> </ul>
Reimbursements & Incentives	<ul> <li>Reimbursement of paid Stamp Duty and Registration Fee.</li> <li>Incentives for adoption of renewable energy in relation to set-up cost components.</li> <li>25% reimbursement on Internet charges. (a maximum of Rs. 2,50,000 per year for the first 3 years of operations)</li> <li>Investment subsidy of 20% on total CAPEX, other than land and building.</li> <li>Prerequisites: Must have signed MoU within 2 years of notification of the policy</li> </ul>
<b>Rental Subsidies</b>	<ul> <li>If located in a Govt. Building:</li> <li>No lease rent or O&amp;M charges shall be levied for 5 years, or until the Incubator is self-sustainable</li> <li>If located in private premises/ taken on lease rent:</li> <li>Reimbursement @ Rs. 5 per sq. ft. per month or 25% of the actual rent paid, whichever is less, shall be reimbursed for a period of 3 years.</li> </ul>

# This policy has enabled the creation of various institutions that support **Start-ups** at their various business stages.

Develop Physical Infrastructure	<ul> <li>Creating Space: 1 million sq. ft. of work-space, dedicated to Start-ups.</li> <li>Global Programs: Partner with 20 global accelerator/Incubator programs.</li> <li>Tier II Regions: Build Incubators in Tier II regions of Telangana.</li> <li>Subsidized Seating: Provide subsidized seating in State-led initiatives. Aid other Incubators in providing subsidized seating to Start-ups.</li> </ul>
Ease of Registration and Doing Business	<ul> <li>TSiPass – Single-window clearance for all approvals required to set-up industries in 15 days</li> <li>Set up of TSIC (Start-up Cell) to host events, provide access to government, promotion innovation &amp; entrepreneurship.</li> <li>Registration on the TSIC Portal for Start-ups to have access to TSIC</li> <li>Any start-up registration should only take up to 12 days</li> </ul>
Steering Committee for Start-ups	<ul> <li>Telangana Innovation Partners Council has been set-up to aid start-up related discussions. Link - <u>https://www.teamtsic.org/contact-us/</u></li> <li>Head of institutions such as TSIC, TASK, RICH, WE Hub, and T-Hub are part of the steering committee for start-up related strategic discussions in the State</li> </ul>
Funding for Start-ups	<ul> <li>The government has launched the T-Angel program to get early stage Start-ups, investment-ready.</li> <li>One of T-Angel's key feature is a 3-month investment acceleration program. The graduates of this program would be will be listed on LetsVenture's investment platform which has over 6000+ active investors.</li> <li>Registrations close on 30<sup>th</sup> September 2019. Please visit - <u>https://t-hub.co/t-angel/</u></li> </ul>
Mentorship	<ul> <li>T-Hub, WE Hub, T-Works, and TSIC provided access to a pool of mentors to beneficiary Start-ups. The list of the same along with mentor-focus areas can be found at – <u>https://www.teamtsic.org/state-mentors-list/</u></li> </ul>

### The Policy also contains all the specific fiscal incentives that GoTS provides for <u>Start-ups</u> to avail.

#### **Promotions**

- Government shall provide reimbursements of 30% of the actual costs including travel incurred in international marketing through trade shows.
- This incentive will be subject to a maximum of Rs. 5 Lakhs per year per company.
- The cost of filing and prosecution of patent application will be reimbursed to the incubated Start-up companies subject to a limit of Rs. 2 Lakhs per Indian patent awarded.

Patent Filing Cost

• For awarded foreign patents, up to Rs. 10 lakh would be reimbursed.

Performance Linked Incentives Start-ups that record a year-on-year growth rate of 15%, as per audited accounts, shall be eligible to get a **grant of 5% on Turnover, subject to a limit of Rs.10 lacs** within a period of three years from the date of incubation.

• To promote idea stage companies, the government shall offer recruitment assistance of **Rs. 10,000 per employee** for the first year.

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# Registration with GoTS is the first step to avail these benefits. Please do so if you have not registered yet.



Start-ups and Incubators can register with GoTS in TSIC's website which acts as the nodal organization for all Start-ups in Telangana.

### Start-ups registering with state will:

- Qualify to avail the benefits in the State Innovation Policy .
- Get timely information and updates reg. state incentives and programs.
- Be able to access to State's start-up ecosystem infrastructures.

## **Govt. Public Procurement Norms for Start-ups in Telangana**

To encourage Government Procurement from start-ups, GoTS addresses the key challenges that have earlier prevented start-ups from participating in public procurement.

### Prerequisites

- Must be a registered entity, and satisfy criteria to qualify as a "Start-up" per Innovation Policy 2016
- Must have a team of 10+ technical staff
- Must have a firm address, contact details and URL address

#### **Relaxation of Procurement Norms**

Start-ups will not be subjected to:

- Prior turnover criteria
- Prior experience in Public Procurement criteria
- Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) submission
- Start-ups shall be given a 15% relaxation on their submitted financial quotations pertaining to procurement, subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications

### **Application Process**

- Submit a covering letter requesting for relaxation of procurement norms along with the forms attached in Annexure 1 of the State Public Policy Norms for Start-ups.
- Start-up will have to be issued a certificate, per Annexure 2 State Public Policy Norms for Start-ups.
- Must submit these documents for a competitive bid to Telangana State Technology Services(TSTS)
