INVESTMENTS

Fiat Chrysler Automobiles

FCA chooses Hyderabad as its largest and only presence outside of its headquarters in North America. They will invest Rs. 1100 Crores and create 1000 jobs in the first year.



Amazon Web Services

AWS has finalized an investment of Rs. 20,761 Crores to set-up multiple data centres in Telangana. Establishment of data centres in the region will increase the operations of sectors such as ecommerce, public sector banking and financial services (BFSI) and IT.



ETO Motors

ETO Motors is set to establish an electric vehicle manufacturing unit with an investment of Rs. 150 Crores. The firm will bring employment opportunities to about 1500 people in the state.



25000+ Govt. School students registered for the Telangana School Innovation in collaboration with Unicef India, Inqui-lab Foundation and Telangana State Education Dept. The students were divided into 9000+ teams and underwent Design Thinking process with the help of teacher guides assigned to each school. 7098 innovative solutions were submitted from across 33 districts of Telangana.



Olectra Greentech

Olectra Greentech is setting up an electric bus manufacturing unit with an outlay of Rs. 300 Crores that will provide employment opportunities to 1500 people.



Mytrah Energy

Mytrah Energy is setting up an electric bus manufacturing unit with an investment of Rs. 2,000 Crores. The firm will add 7000 people to the state's workforce.



Hindustan Sanitaryware & Industries Limited

HSIL is ready to invest Rs. 320 Crores in two units in Telangana. Of this, Rs. 220 Crores will be invested in AGI Glaspac to manufacture specialty glass in Bhongir and Rs. 100 Crores will be invested in pipes and fittings unit at Sangareddy.

Granules India and Laurus Labs

Hyderabad has attracted two major investments in Genome Valley. Granules India is investing Rs 400 crore to set up a finished dosages unit while Laurus Labs is investing Rs 300 crore for a formulations manufacturing facility. Granules India will generate about 1600 employment.

NALGONDA

PROFILE: Nalgonda was originally known as Nilagiri. The district is bounded by Khammam and Krishna districts on the East, Hyderabad, R.R. district, Mahaboobnagar districts on the West, Medak and Warangal districts on North. Lime stone, laterite, quartz and lead clay are the major minerals found in the district. Other resources include milch animals and poultry. The major crops in the district are paddy, bajra, groundnut, redgram, castor, cotton, citrus and mango.

PRESENT SCENARIO: According to TS-iPASS, the total investment in the newly approved industries amounts to Rs. 183 crores. The total employment provided is 2355. In this district, major share of the investment in newly approved units has gone to rice mills, poultry and cotton spinning. 12 persons are employed per Rs. 1 crore of investment, on average. The main industries in the district include Rice mills, Cotton Spinning and weaving, Parboiled Rice mills, Vegetable oil manufacturing, Jobbing and machining.

POTENTIAL: There is a potential for the following industries: Stone crushing, Agricultural implements, biogas equipment, mini diary, flour mills, stone ware pipes, Fly ash bricks, Paper products, Plastic products, leather tanning units.

NIZAMABAD

PROFILE: It shares its boundaries with Adilabad district to the north, Karimnagar district to the east, Medak District to the south, Nanded district in Maharashtra to the west. The major mineral resources in the district are Coloured granite, gravel, stone and metals. Other resources include milch animals and fisheries. The major crops grown in the district include paddy, sugarcane, maize, turmeric, cotton, groundnut, sunflower and pulses.

PRESENT SCENARIO: According to TS-iPASS, the total investment in the newly approved industries amounts to Rs.114 crores. The total employment provided is 1859. In this district, major share of the investment in newly approved units has gone to rice mills, stone crushers and polythene. The main industries in the district include Rice mill, Engineering and fabrication, Plastic Products, Stone crushers, Mineralized water and Dairy Products.

POTENTIAL: There is a potential for the following industries: Agro based industries, Horticulture, Spices Grinding, Mineral based industries and Rice mills. Major exportable items in this district are boiled rice, rice bran oil, rice flakes, particle boards from paddy husk, corn flakes and maize.

Taking SNIPR (Smart Nano molecules Induced Physiological Response) technology to Indian farmers

Founded by three researchers, BioPrime Agri Solutions, a company developing affordable agri biologicals, has increased its presence in twelve states across the country including Telangana within two years, with its unique products manufactured using SNIPR technology. RICH, as part of its start-up promotion and technology introduction activities, identified BioPrime and started mentoring Dr. Renuka and other founders. At the inception of the RICH mentoring program, the company's annual revenue was at Rs. 10 lakhs. RICH facilitated business partnership with Delta Agrigenetics, which took SNIPR products across all major states to record annual revenue of Rs. 3 crores within two seasons. High level of acceptance of BioPrime's products among the farmers led Delta Agrigenetics to make an investment of Rs. 18 crores in BioPrime. Currently, the company is valued at Rs. 85 crores.

Clinically proven cereal mix for Diabetes

People with diabetes constantly struggle to find foods that are suitable for their needs. The increasing demand for special foods has led to the introduction of several diabetic food products. However, very few of these brands are clinically proven for controlling diabetes. Mr. Amar Babu and Mr. VVP Vasi Reddy, researchers at Dr. Reddy's Laboratory and Vimta Labs, identified this gap and started Med C Pharma to formulate cereals for diabetic people. After three years of intense research, the desired cereal mix was developed. Clinical trials conducted at one of the leading hospitals in Hyderabad gave them the scientific evidence of the effect of their product in reducing blood sugar levels.

RICH connected Med C Pharma to big industry players for marketing the product rather than going through the regular distribution network. RICH facilitated manufacturing agreement between Med C Pharma and one of South Asia's biggest pharmacy

chains. As a result of this intervention from RICH, the cereal mix of Med C Pharma will be sold in more than 4000 pharmacy outlets by the end of 2020. The business is expected to generate sales amounting to Rs. 200 crores in the next two vears.
